AWARD OF PROPOSAL FOR HOME CONSORTIUM FY2011 RENTAL HOUSING RE:

PROGRAM

Tulsa County, as the lead entity for the Metropolitan Tulsa HOME Consortium, solicited Requests for Proposals for new construction or rehabilitation of rental housing, or land acquisition for rental housing from organizations certified as Consortium Community Housing Development Organizations (CHDO's) or Non Profit Certified Developers. HOMÉ monies from Fiscal Years 2011 through FY2013 are available to fund projects that promote affordable housing within the Consortium service area, and by special exception in the City of Tulsa. Proposals were received by the County on August 5, 2013.

One CHDO (Community Action Resource and Development- CARD) and one Certified Developer (Mental Health Association in Tulsa- MHAT) responded to the RFP. CARD has withdrawn their proposal for rental housing. MHAT submitted a proposal for capital improvement projects at two (2) low income multi-family apartment complexes owned by MHAT. The capital improvement projects will assist in providing safe and affordable housing for low-income households, homeless and chronically homeless families and individuals and those at risk of homelessness. The amount of HOME funds requested by MHAT was The HOME Consortium previously funded MHAT for homelessness \$1,386,539.32. prevention through the Recovery Act Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Rehousing program, through which MHAT demonstrated an excellent history of contract performance. After award of funding in the amount of \$1,386,539.32 to MHAT, a balance of \$668,405.70 remains available for funding.

Therefore, staff recommends that the Board of County Commissioners approve the following agency for funding in the following amount:

Mental Health Association in Tulsa: \$1,386,539.32
