**SUBJECT:** Rental of Komatsu Excavator

In September, 2015, Tulsa County was approximately 40% to 50% complete on a road widening project on Garnett Road, between 81st and 91st Street South. Tulsa County owns a Cat 325 excavator that was being used on this project. Due to age and wear, this excavator had to be pulled from the project for some major repairs. To keep the project moving, Highway Construction rented a Komatsu 290 Excavator from Kirby Smith Machinery. The rent was \$6700 for the excavator and \$400 for a 48" bucket. While this office failed to recognize that rental fees since that time have exceeded that allowed by Purchasing, the equipment was vital to keeping the project moving forward. We expect the return of the Cat 325 in the next week, and will be returning the Komatsu to Kirby Smith at the end of the current rental period.
